"APARTADO" COMES FROM THE SPANISH VERB "APARTAR", WHICH MEANS THAT IT IS "SET APART" FROM THE REST. THE COMPOSITION OF THE WINES VARIES EACH YEAR DEPENDING ON THE BEST BARRELS OF THE HARVEST. THE APARTADO RANGE REPRESENTS THE TRUE RICHNESS OF THE VINEYARDS IN THE UCO VALLEY.



Varietals: 30% Cabernet Sauvignon from Tupungato, 20% Cabernet Franc from Tupungato, 30% Malbec from La Consulta, 20% Syrah from Altamira.



Vineyards: Tupungato, Altamira, La Consulta; Mendoza.



Malolactic Fermentation: 100%.



Oak Regime: 24 months in 50% new French oak, 50% 2nd use.



Winemaker: Mariano Di Paola.

Winemaker's Notes: Intense red color with delicate violet hues. Elegant and fruity in the nose, accompanied by pleasant notes of spices and hints of chocolate and tobacco imparted by oak ageing. On the palate this is a complex wine with great structure and smooth, powerful tannins. This is an elegant blend with a big personality.
