GRAN CHARDONNAY



“APARTADO” COMES FROM THE SPANISH VERB “APARTAR”, WHICH MEANS THAT IT IS “SET APART” FROM THE REST. THE COMPOSITION OF THE WINES VARIES EACH YEAR DEPENDING ON THE BEST BARRELS OF THE HARVEST. THE APARTADO RANGE REPRESENTS THE TRUE RICHNESS OF THE VINEYARDS IN THE UCO VALLEY.



Varietals: 90% Chardonnay, 7% Semillón, 3% Pinot Grigio.



Vineyards: Chardonnay from Tupungato, Semillón from Tupungato, Pinot Grigio from La Consulta, Mendoza.



Malolactic Fermentation: 50%.



Oak Regime: 100% new French oak for 12 months.



Winemaker: Mariano Di Paola.



Winemaker's Notes: The Rutini Apartado Gran Chardonnay is a robust, yet refreshing blend made with the best white varietals of the harvest. The grapes for this wine were carefully hand-picked at peak maturity, fostering the development of rich tropical fruit aromas in perfect balance with crisp acidity.
