## GRAN MALBEC



"APARTADO" COMES FROM THE SPANISH VERB "APARTAR", WHICH MEANS THAT IT IS "SET APART" FROM THE REST. THE COMPOSITION OF THE WINES VARIES EACH YEAR DEPENDING ON THE BEST BARRELS OF THE HARVEST. THE APARTADO RANGE REPRESENTS THE TRUE RICHNESS OF THE VINEYARDS IN THE UCO VALLEY.



Varietals: 100% Malbec.



Vineyards: Tupungato, La Consulta and Altamira, Mendoza.



Malolactic Fermentation: 100%.



Oak Regime: 100% French oak barrels for 18 months.



Winemaker: Mariano Di Paola.



Winemaker's Notes: An intense but silky red Malbec with purple undertones. On the nose it is elegant, floral aromas blend with fruity notes. Complex mouthfeel, concentrated but smooth. Fruity and potent character with hints of licorice and notes of toasty cocoa beans and coffee imparted by French oak. This grand Malbec stands out from the rest with a prolonged and unforgettable finish.
